Ken Anderson is executive vice president/general manager of Tri-State Generation and Transmission Association, leading the \$3.7 billion wholesale electric power supplier's executive management team in its strategic and operational initiatives, while reporting to the association's 44-member board of directors.



He joined the association in February 2005 as senior vice president of transmission, and then served as senior vice president of generation and power management before becoming general manager in July 2008. Anderson has more than 26 years of executive managerial experience in areas that include project origination, utility operations and finance responsibilities in both the international and domestic energy marketplace.

Prior to beginning his service at Tri-State, Anderson was a technical consultant for the U.S. Department of Homeland Security and before that (1996 to 2004), he served as chief operating officer for Western Farmers Electric Cooperative headquartered in Anadarko, Okla.

Anderson represents Tri-State on a number of affiliated organizations' boards of directors, including the Electric Power Research Institute, the National Renewable Cooperative Organization and Western Fuels Association. He also contributes his time and effort through his active membership in several professional utility associations, including the Institute of Electrical and Electronic Engineers since 1980.

An author of numerous published technical papers and a recipient of the H.W. Sweatt Engineer-Scientist Award in 1993, Anderson earned a bachelor's degree in electrical engineering from Texas Tech University and a master's degree in electrical and computer engineering from the University of Colorado in Boulder.
